

# Town of Elon Leaf Pick up

The Town provides leaf pick up at the curb. Our procedure is to continually make rounds working from one end of the Town to the other as many times as possible throughout the leaf season. This allows us to give many more visits to each resident than larger Towns. If the weather cooperates and our equipment has no problems we should visit everyone in Town at least once per week until the week of Thanksgiving. Due to the heavier influx of leaves at this time residences will be visited as soon as possible but not less than once every two weeks until we catch back up, which usually takes a few weeks then we will return to at least once per week as soon as possible. This schedule is highly dependent on weather, equipment and cooperation of everyone. It is our goal at The Town of Elon to get your leaves as soon and as many times as possible throughout leaf season.

To help with this please observe the following:

- Leaf pick up begins October 15th
- Place leaves close to the roadway, not in the roadway
- Make sure there are no limbs, sticks, rocks, bricks, etc. in leaves. These can clog up the machine, cause damage and greatly delay this service. Piles found with debris in them will NOT be picked up.
- Do not place leaves in bags before January 14<sup>th</sup>
- Keep vehicles out of the pathway of leaf piles
