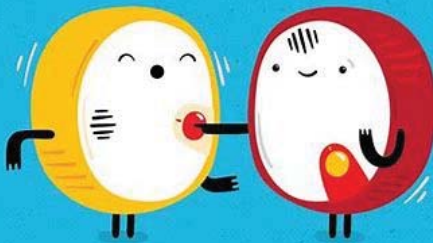

DID YOU KNOW...

- One out of four fatal victims of smoking-material fires is not the smoker whose cigarette started the fire

REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCE APPROVED AT AUGUST MEETING

The Board of Aldermen approved the updates to the Town's Code of Ordinances on August 14, 2018. These are the laws that govern our community and is enforced locally in addition to state and federal laws. The entire code is available on the town's website at www.elonnc.com under documents. To receive a written copy or for questions you may call the Town Clerk, DiAnne Enoch at (336) 584-3601 or visit the town's municipal building at 104 S. Williamson Avenue.

To report a code violation, you may reach our State Code Enforcement Officer, Dennis Pinnix at (336)586-1016 or complete the complaint form on the town's website at www.elonnc.com.

RESIDENTIAL WASTE, RECYCLABLES, HEAVY GARBAGE SERVICES

For your convenience, you may find the collection schedule for residential waste, recyclables and yard waste, the scheduling provisions for heavy waste pick-up, and ordinances pertaining to these services, on the town's website www.elonnc.com. You may also request a written schedule and the code of ordinance details at the Town of Elon Municipal Building located at 104 S. Williamson Avenue, Elon.

Residential Waste – Place waste and recyclable receptacles curbside no earlier than the day before and remove them no later than the day after collection

Recyclables – Separate recyclables from waste. A list of items that are recyclable is posted on the town's website

Yard Waste – Yard waste does not go to the landfill; therefore, the resident must properly prepare or containerize for separate collection

- All trimmings and limbs must be cut in lengths not to exceed six feet
- Leaves must be bagged and placed curbside EXCEPT October 15 – January 14 when the town will vacuum leaves piled at curbside. Keep piles away from signs, mailboxes, parked vehicles
- Grass trimmings must be bagged and placed curbside for removal

Heavy Garbage/Bulk Pick-Up – For information on what this includes, set fees, and when and how pick-up may be scheduled, please visit the town's website or request written details from the town's administrative offices

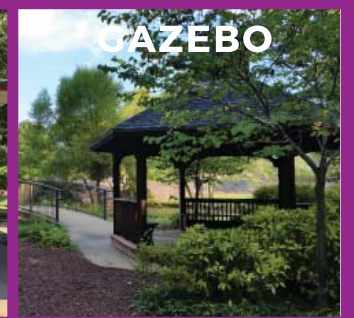
